

# Simple Steps for Educators on how to use the VR sets

Kindly note that these are very simple steps to start you off and start using the VRs. For more information refer to the following link: Setup & User Guide

- 1. Log into Classconnect and click on Accept for your VR organisation
- 2. Click on the **pencil** to change organisation eg. St Nicholas-VR
- 3. Teacher logs into platform: http://portal.classvr.com/connect/player/index.cfm
- 4. Click on **Microsoft** and log in using ilearn credentials
- 5. Teacher needs to check if he/she has access to platform before delivering any VR lesson
- 6. Click on Profile pic to access Settings
- 7. Check /Change **Organisation** (eg. St Nicholas- VR)
- 8. Click on the Plan tab
- 9. Click on Community or Subscriptions to search for playlists eg. Space
- 10. Drag & Drop the playlist you have searched for
- 11. The playlist with all the videos will show on the left hand side with individual videos
- 12. These can be re-ordered and deleted if necessary
- 13. To delete a track, click on the waffle and drag it out



- 14. Click on the **Delivery** Tab
- 15. Device controls are locked. Tap the list on the right hand side to unlock.
- 16. Click on the **Send** button to push the playlist on the VRs



- 17. Open the VR box with all the VR sets
- 18. Switch on the VRs
- 19. All the VRs connected will be shown in the yellow list on the right hand side

# Saving a Playlist

- Click on the Plan tab
- Click on **Community** tab to access all playlists
- Search for a topic in the Search field eg Ancient Greece
- Drag & Drop the chosen playlist to the Playlist window on the left
- The playlist with all the tracks will show on the left hand side
- These can be re-ordered and deleted if necessary
- Click on the save button, name your playlist and click Save

## **Using the Classview and Preview**

- To return to the head-tracking image, simply click Preview
- To check all your ClassVR headsets are functioning correctly, take a look at the Devices pane to the right of the screen.
- From here, you can tell if your devices are connected to the network. Once they are in use (being worn), they will show as **Active**.
- To return your headsets to student-directed mode, press the home button. This will
  return the headset to the menu screen, where students can use gesture controls to
  open specific experiences.

#### Installing a 360 video from youtube

- Download video from youtube . You can use: <a href="https://ssyoutube.com/en3/youtube-video-downloader">https://tuberipper.com/</a>
- Click on My Cloud
- Click on Upload
- Save to 'My Playlist'
- Click on the **Send** button to send the playlist on Devices

## Using the Class VR hand controller

- Navigation Controller (Knob) to navigate the list of videos
- Option ('3 lines') button settings menu: brightness, volume and Force Close
- Back button back to the main menu
- Trigger action button ('Ok' button on the top) to select

#### Switching off all VR sets

- Go to Deliver tab
- Click on Manage Devices (cog wheel bottom right)
- Shutdown
